## OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-2019

Strata Energy, Inc. (Strata) is committed to a concept we refer to as "Community Energy", a core belief of which is that a partnership is implicitly created with the communities in which we operate. To foster this partnership, Strata seeks to create opportunities for young people within these communities to pursue educational success through Strata's Opportunity Scholarship program.

The Opportunity Scholarship is an annual scholarship available to high school seniors graduating from high schools and accredited home-school programs located in Crook County, Wyoming. The \$500 scholarship is awarded to one recipient per academic year.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

*Residency:* The applicant must be a legal resident of the State of Wyoming.

*Education:* The applicant must receive a high-school diploma from an accredited Crook County high school or Crook County home-school program. GEDs may be accepted on a case-by-case basis. An applicant may be awarded the scholarship prior to graduation, but if the applicant fails to graduate or otherwise complete the education requirement, they will forfeit the scholarship and it will be awarded to another applicant.

*Program of Study:* The scholarship is available to students pursuing higher education in any field of study at an accredited trade school, community college, or university.

*Recommended Academic Criteria:* The applicant must meet the following minimum academic criteria:

- 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA
- SAT score of 1000+ OR ACT score of 22+
- Applicants not meeting the academic criteria but fulfilling all other criteria is encouraged to apply, as a final decision for the scholarship will be based on an applicant's all-around candidacy rather than exclusively on academics.

*Additional Factors:* The applicant is encouraged to include information regarding extra-curricular or additional academic activities in the application for review. These factors will be considered along with the information above in selecting the best applicant to receive the scholarship.
